William's mother was Lillia Vincett, born in Hythe in 1866, and living with her aunt, Charlotte Rootes, widow of John Rootes, at Pear Tree Cottage, as it is now known, when William was born. William was baptized in Canterbury by his mother and it is believed that his father, Frederick "Tommy" Palmer, provided for him.

William was fostered by Mr. & Mrs. Court and he lived with them all his life in Ann's Cottage.

William's mother married in Dover in 1903, and may have had no further contact with him (but we don't know).
